- ☐ Funds between \$500 and \$7,500 PLUS provides 100% reimbursement up to \$1,000 for any safety improvements made and personal protective equipment (PPE) purchased between March 2020 – July 2020 to protect the health of employees and patrons
- ☐ Business CANNOT be located within the city limits of Del Rio, Texas
- ☐ Business must have been in operation before March 2019
- ☐ Business must be in Complete Closure due to Governor's Executive Order# GA-14, or impacted by Amistad Lake closure
